## Climate

Medellin is famously called “The City of Eternal Spring.” Located 1,495 meters above sea level, it enjoys a mild and humid climate, with temperatures ranging from 18°C to 28°C (65°F to 82°F).



## Currency

The official currency in Colombia is the Colombian Peso (COP).



## Airports

José María Córdova International Airport is located just 30 minutes from Medellín, offering convenient access to the city. Taxi transfers cost approximately COP 120,000 (around USD 35), while shuttle bus services cost about COP 17,000 (approximately USD 5).

Olaya Herrera Airport, located within the city, operates domestic flights daily from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.



## Transportation

Medellin offers an efficient and integrated public transportation network, including the Metro, Metroplús, Metrocable, feeder buses, taxis, and ride-hailing platforms.

Both the Metro and Metroplús systems provide direct access to Plaza Mayor, the venue of the Feria de las 2 Ruedas. The Metroplús station is called Plaza Mayor, and the Metro station is Exposiciones.



## Voltage and Plug Type

In Colombia, the standard electrical supply is 110V AC (60Hz). We recommend using a voltage regulator to protect your devices from possible power fluctuations.

Power outlets are type A and B, compatible with two flat prongs or an additional round grounding pin.




Plaza Mayor is Medellín's International Convention and Exhibition Center, located in the Alpujarra district.
